Located within Scott County is State Reservoir, Hardy Lake. Its 2,178 + acres and 741 acre lake is complete with campgrounds, a beach, playgrounds, basketball and volleyball courts, an archery range, hiking trails, fishing piers and open play-fields. At Hardy Lake -- there's something for

everyone to enjoy! Ice fishing is a favorite during the winter months, as well as a visit to the Raptor Center.

- **Indianapolis Motor Speedway** -- The Indianapolis Motor Speedway plays host annually to three premier world racing events: The Indianapolis 500-Mile Race, the Brickyard 400 and the United States Grand Prix.
- **Kentucky Derby** -- Experience the excitement and pageantry that is world-class thoroughbred racing by visiting Churchill Downs in Louisville, Kentucky.
- **Cincinnati Reds** -- The Reds will continue their tradition of playing ball along the waterfront when the team takes the field in Great American Ball Park.
