### Overview for Scott County, IN

Part of: Scottsburg IN, Metropolitan Area

Scott County has 190.4 sq. miles in land area and a population density of 124.5 per square mile. In the last three decades of the 1900s, its population grew by 33.9%. The average household size is 2.58 persons compared to an average family size of 2.99 persons.

In 2005, manufacturing was the largest of 20 major employment sectors, with an average wage of \$35,831 per job. Between 1995 and 2005, per capita income grew by 10.4% (adjusted for inflation).

## Recreation – State Parks/Reservoirs

Located within Scott County is State Reservoir, Hardy Lake. Its 2,178 + acres and 741 acre lake is complete with campgrounds, a beach, playgrounds, basketball and volleyball courts, an archery range, hiking trails, fishing piers and open play-fields.

## Recreational Attractions Nearby

Scott County, Indiana is located between three major metropolitan areas: Indianapolis, Indiana; Louisville, Kentucky; and Cincinnati, Ohio, which offer a wide variety of special events and attractions, some of which include:
